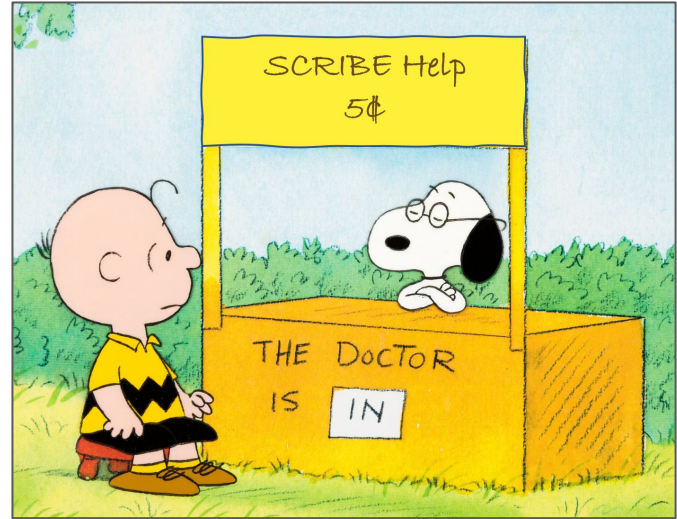

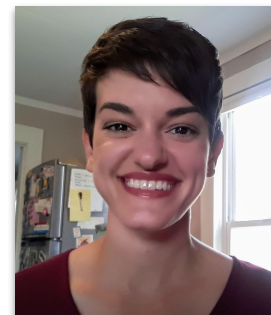

Grade > **680 records**

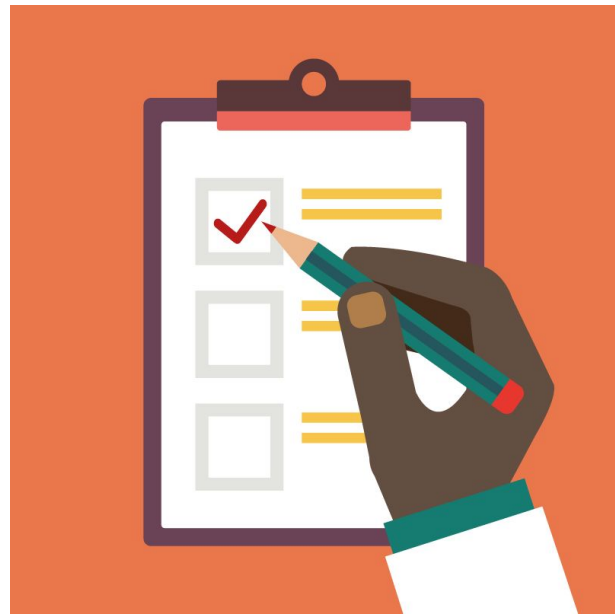

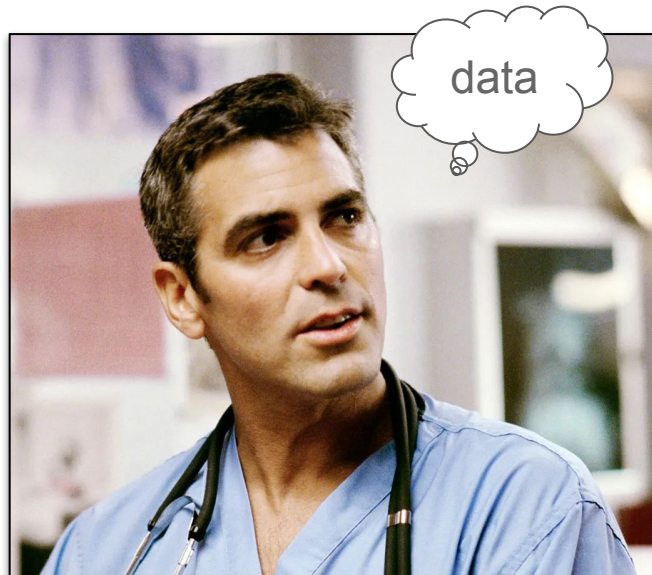

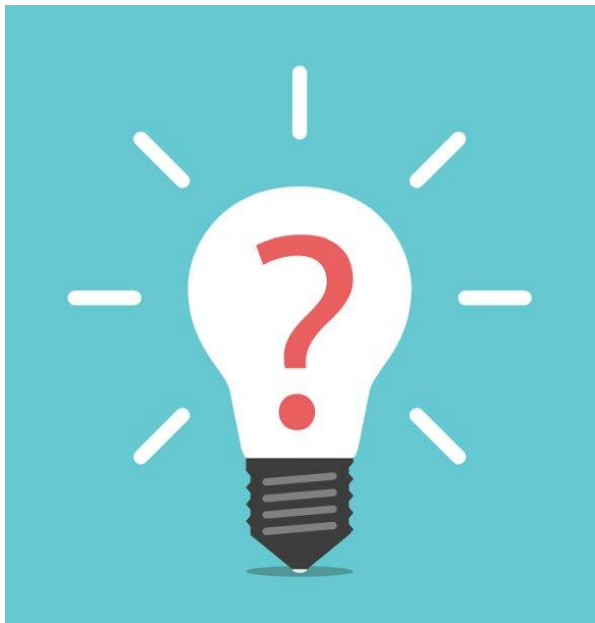

Connecting Parents and Students

The only way to access family members is through a student. Family members are dependent on their respective students.

When importing participation you use the student's ID.

Key Questions for Family Data

- Are you importing students or creating them manually?
- Are you tracking family data (e.g. name and contact information), or are you tracking generic data about parents (e.g. the parent/guardian of Zach Morris)?



Connecting Parents and Students

Importing Students


- Some grants are set up to create a set number of “generic” family members for students when they are first created.
- In this case, students have to be created through an import.
- Family members for students created manually must be created manually.
- Talk to the Xcalibur team to determine whether your grant is set up to create “generic” family members automatically.
- “Generic” family members can be changed to “specific” family members through a student enrollment import.



Connecting Parents and Students

Manually Creating Parents

- Access a student.
- Click on the Family tab.
- Click Add.
- Enter the required data.

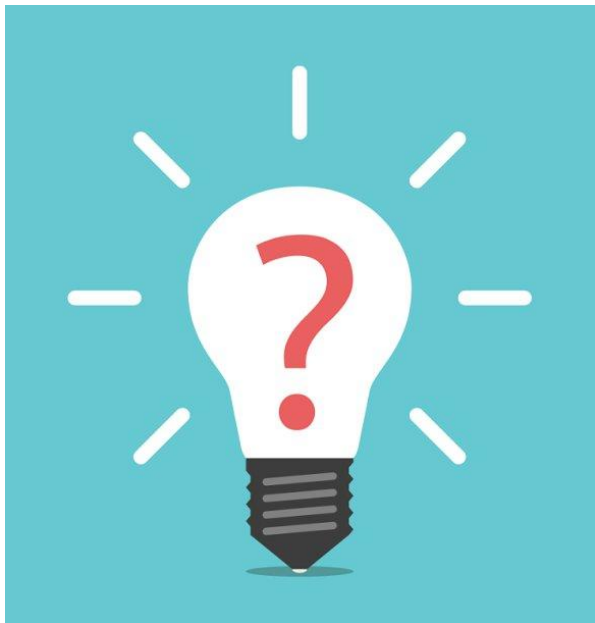

- Live with your data infrastructure for the school year.

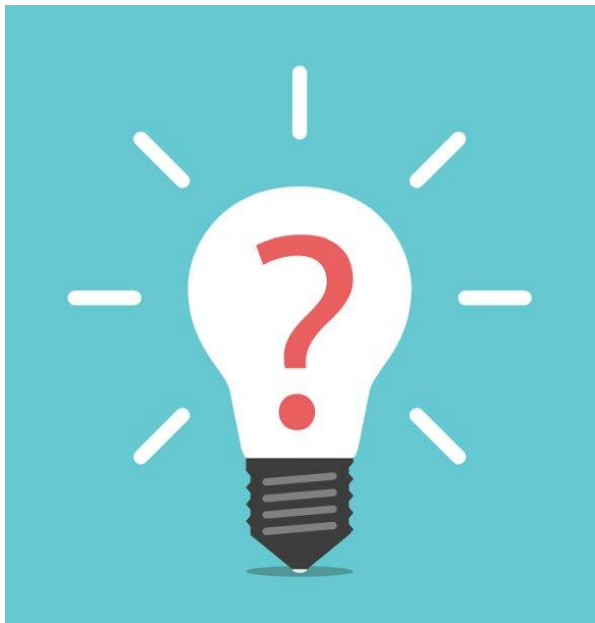


Top 5 Aspects of SCRIBE

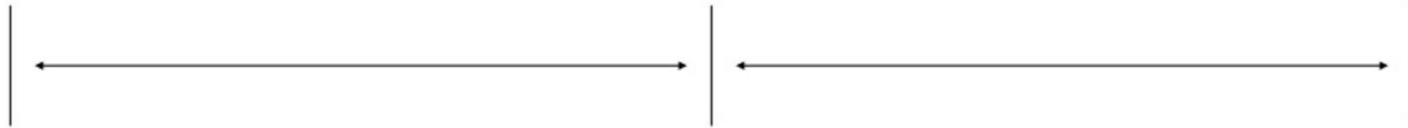
