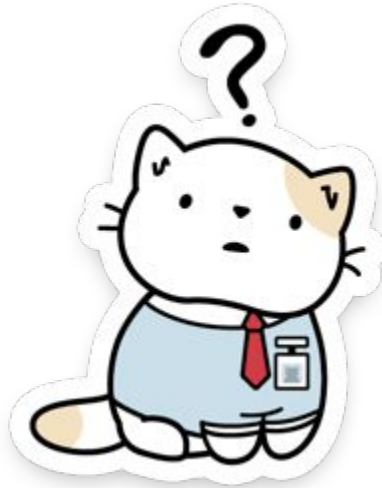

2. Own the you-problems ●
3. Consider the them-problems
4. Acknowledge the context
5. Talk to the person honestly ●

- Clear roles and expectations?

- Internal biases?

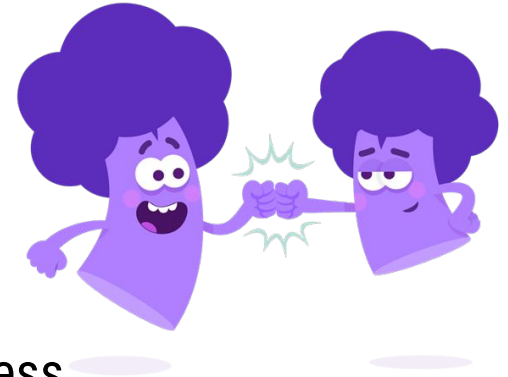


- Connect
- Review expectations, share your observations, their impact, and make an ask
- Determine explanation together
- Devise new solutions
- Create clear responsibilities, expectations, and follow up plan
- Follow up

Data Thank You Nots

Quick fixes or preventative steps

- Build your relationships
- Communicate roles and responsibilities clearly
- Consistently share the “why”
- Be clear with your asks - don't hide them
- Check in regularly
- Act with confidence - or acknowledge the awkwardness
- Show gratitude

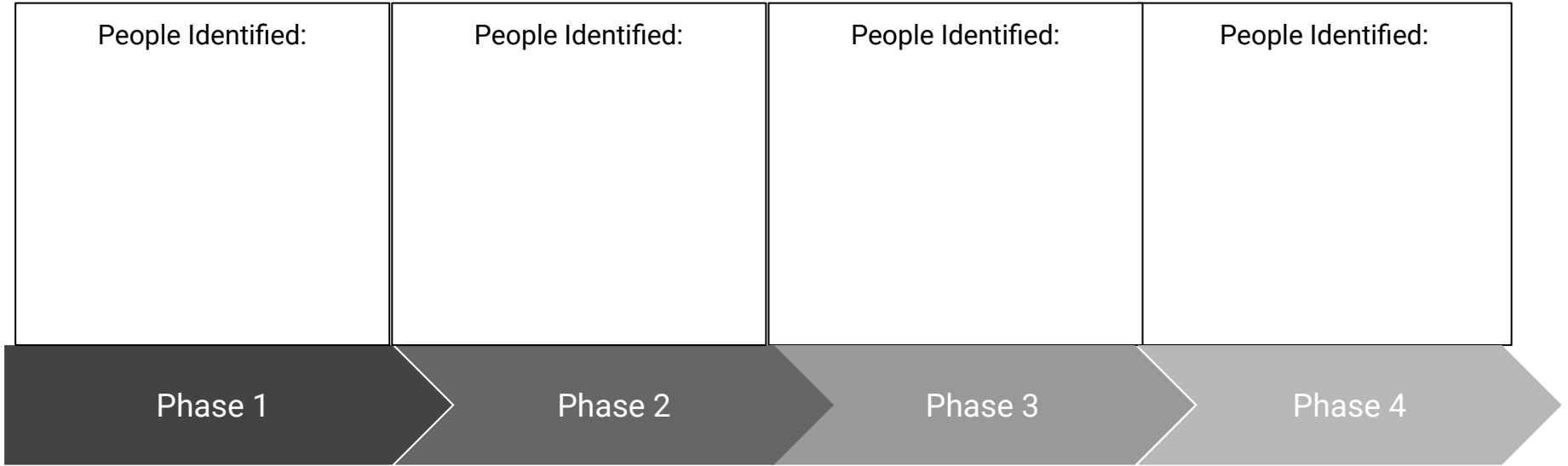
