



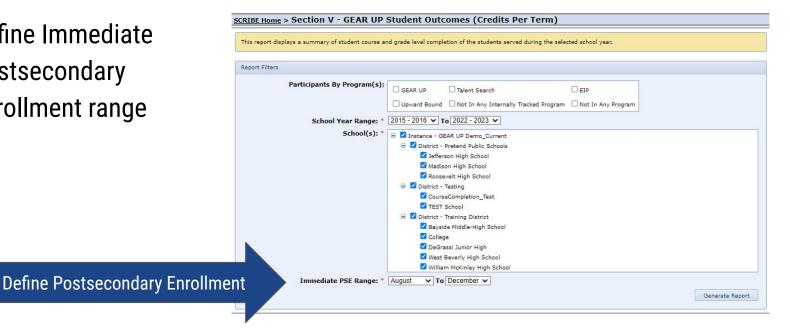

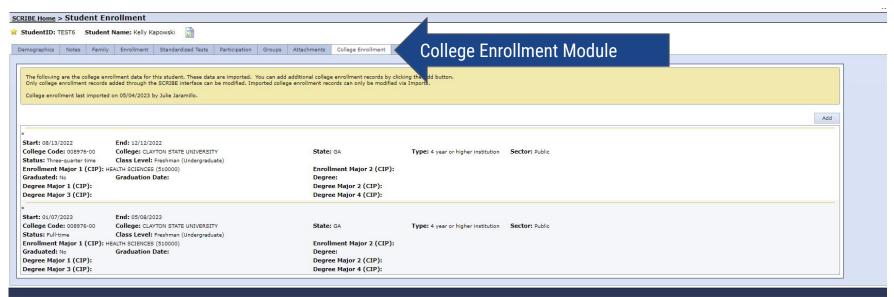
Define Immediate Postsecondary **Enrollment range**

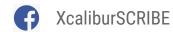

- Review Standard Courses and Course grades across school year.
- Review the <u>FAFSA Submission Date</u> field.

New for 2023!

- Ensure all of your graduates have an <u>exit code</u> indicating graduation.
- Start using the College Enrollment Module to track postsecondary enrollment.
